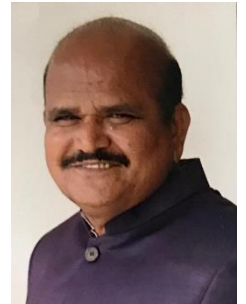

Quiz Competition

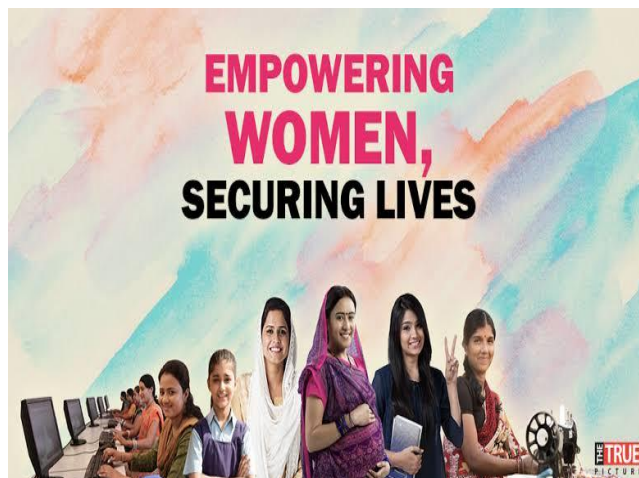
